I've got several pieces of good news for you today! First, our baptism service on Sunday was almost halted by a lack of water in the Courtyard Marriott swimming pool, but then turned into the beautiful moment you see pictured in the header. Thank you Carlos, Eva, and Jenn for being flexible in what became an epic testimony moment! Roof baptisms can't happen regularly, but this one was under a special set of circumstances. Second, TJ and the student team broke another record with 36 attending the youth service on Wednesday! God is good to us! And finally, the Lord continues in his affirmation of the tire shop! We received word last night that we passed our environmental assessment—the space held auto parts, but no oil, gas, etc was regularly used there and the soil is

in verifiably good shape! We will be continuing to pray before signing our final lease, but all indications are that God is paving the way for us to add this space.

In light of this last update I have a big request—this Sunday night at 6pm we will be meeting (after our typical 8:30, 9:45, and 11:15am services) at our current sanctuary for free Olive Garden and a tour of the new facility! During the tour, Denver will be bringing his guitar so we can sing the first songs of worship in the space and I'll be preaching a short 10 minute vision message. Then we will pray and head back to the current sanctuary for dessert. Childcare will be available. We also have a couple of other surprises, but I don't want to spoil it. :) If you are able to attend, please reply to this message so we know how much food to buy.

I'd also like to ask you to consider giving to this project. The construction and our monthly rent on the space is going to be intense, but still very doable if we all pitch in. 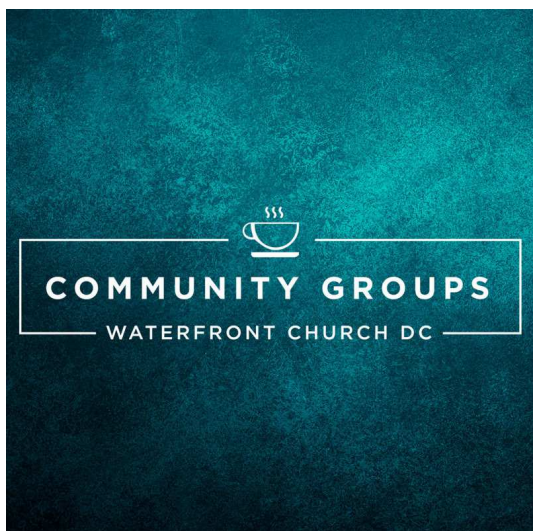

SURGE

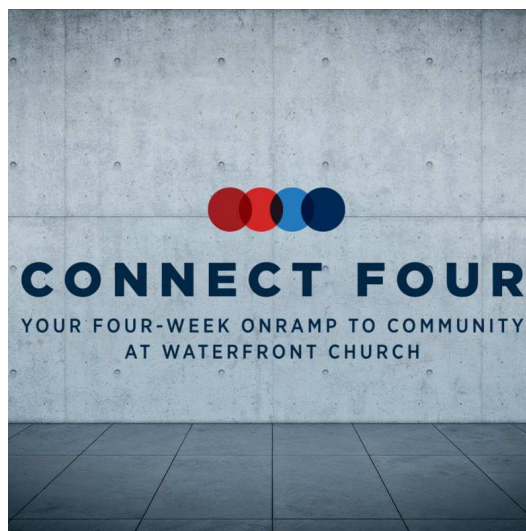
